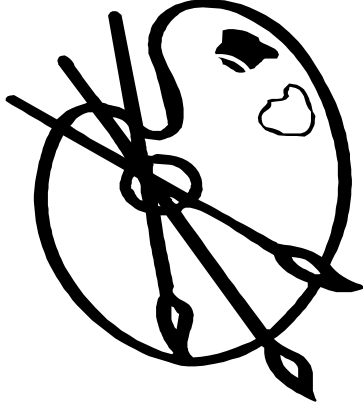

MISSION

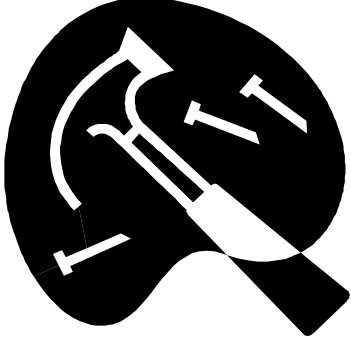

The Artisan Center has been a dream of Gene Davidson for many years. He sought to build a workshop where craftsmen and artists could foster and develop their creative talents.



The Artisan Center is now a reality. It is 7200 sq. ft. with shops for wood and metal working and two classrooms designated for painting, drawing, pottery, and other arts and crafts.

Members bring their own supplies and are provided with an environment in which to peacefully create and share knowledge.



The Artisan Center will be operated by member volunteers. Members are encouraged and expected to contribute staffing, cleaning and other task as needed.

HOURS OF OPERATION:

Wednesday through Sunday: 8:30 A. M. to 5:30 P. M. or by **calling and scheduling other times.**

Note: While working in the wood or metal shops, two people must be present, one of whom must be safety qualified,

Lockdown and lockout procedures will be adhered to with equipment in the wood and metal shops.

Safety Orientation and Release of Liability must be completed before using the PALC.
